

Parking Do's and Don'ts



Marsh Creek State Park (designated areas only)
Acme
Stadium Grille



Boat Ramp area
Hickory Field (ball field)
Along Park roads



Arrive early. Parking inside Park is on a first-come, first-serve basis.
Pay close attention to volunteer/staff directing traffic for directions on where to park.
Only park in designated parking areas.
Watch for pedestrians/athlete walking along the Park road from parking area to packet pick and transition.
For the safety of the athletes, spectators and friends should arrive before 7:00am.



Park along park roads
For the safety of the athletes, spectator and friends do not arrive after 7:00am.
Plan to leave once you have arrived. This is a short, fast race. Spectators can view the race from the transition area.
Park in undesignated lots including the Park boat ramp area, Park roads and Hickory Field (ball field) about 3/4 mile from Park.
Argue with volunteers/staff about parking. Excessive arguing will result in a DQ.

IMPORTANT PARKING INFORMATION

Parking inside Marsh Creek State Park is limited to 500 parking spaces and will be available on a first-come, first-service basis. Overflow parking will be available at the Acme parking lot located approximately 1 mile from the park entrance. We strongly recommend that you arrive early and carpool. Also, spectators are strongly encouraged to arrive with you rather than in a separate vehicle. If it is not possible to come to the race site together, all spectators should arrive before the race start at 7:00am. Arriving after the race starts will create safety issues on the course since the park entrance and exit are the same.
